LUI Position of Operation Statement

Louisiana United International, Inc. (LUI) is a civil, constitutional, and human rights organization, especially committed to eliminating unlawful discrimination in the state of Louisiana. That includes all forms of illegal bias against Louisiana residents, including those historically protected as well as the nouveau repressed.

LUI is a nonprofit, membership-based organization, presently operated on an all-volunteer basis. The organization, its leaders, and other active members work diligently to combat and expose public sector corruption within Louisiana. That work regularly calls for in-depth research and investigations as well as state-wide, national and even international outreach.

LUI is a nonprofit organization; however, it is not a law firm, charity or religious organization, nor an educational institution.

The organization exists to provide the following services:

- Assistance regarding unlawful discrimination
- Assistance regarding unduly coerced plea agreements
- Assistance regarding less than unanimous state jury conviction
- Assistance regarding inmate neglect or abuse
- Assistance regarding U.S. law enforcement, correctional officer, etc.
- Assistance regarding Child Protective Services abuses
- Assistance regarding whistleblower retaliation
- Assistance regarding Human Rights Defender retaliation

LUI is a voice for the people; we provide sincere advocacy services for our members. We go to battle when their civil and constitutional rights have been violated. We implement investigated and structured actions to eliminate corruption and injustice.

LUI cannot guarantee a specific outcome or process by which a member case may be processed; each case has its own unique circumstances. It may be determined that some member service requests will be addressed via a broader avenue opposed to individually.

A common misconception is that when you join LUI, become a member, for services or support only, you are retaining LUI services. LUI is not a law firm; your membership allows you to obtain the services described above by the organization. Anyone requesting LUI services must be a member. Your LUI membership acknowledges that you have joined an organization who is sincere, passionate, and 100% dedicated to helping serve its members.

LUI provides services to LUI members only. Our annual Individual (\$25) and Family Membership (\$50) fees are affordable. Family Membership consists of parents and all children under the age of 18 years old. Membership has to be renewed annually.

Once you become a LUI member, enter your member service request, if any, the agency will respond to your request in the quickest manner possible.
